Villa Walsh Academy Dress Code

At Villa Walsh Academy, we proudly wear our uniforms with a sense of belonging, knowing we are all connected as one student body.

A Villa Walsh Academy uniform consists of:

Skirt:

- A green/navy plaid skirt should be a modest length, not shorter than one inch above the knees.
- Skirts may not be rolled at the waist.

Shirt:

• White monogrammed, banded shirt with long or short sleeves

Sweaters:

- White "Chapel" cardigan sweater
- Dark green or navy blue monogrammed pullover
- Sweaters are to be worn over the uniform shirt. They are never to be worn alone.
- Sweaters can only be purchased through Flynn & O'Hara.

Socks/Tights

- Navy blue knee socks or navy blue tights
- Socks are to be worn at the knee length position not folded or slouched down.

Shoes:

- Shoes should be a simple style and conservative color.
- Students may NOT wear the following footwear: Boots Platforms Flats or Heels Sandals Clogs Flip-Flops Slipper-style Backless Shoes Moccasins
- Students are permitted to wear sneakers during Phys. Ed. Class or with a pass from the school nurse.

Tag Day:

- Tag Days are days on which students do not need to wear their uniforms.
- Students are allowed to wear casual clothing appropriate to VWA standards as stated in the handbook.
- Tag Days occur throughout the year to celebrate a holiday or to raise money for a cause.
- Days usually have a theme of the day, which all students are expected to follow.

Spiritwear:

- On designated tag/spirit days, other items purchased from the boutique may be worn.
- These include spirit rugby shirts and non-uniform polos, among others.
- In addition, on tag/spirit days, club shirts and/or VWA athletic shirts are permissible.

Options:

- Students are permitted to wear Villa Walsh Academy sweatshirts purchased from the School Boutique.
- All other VWA club or sport sweatshirts may be worn only on a Tag Day or on a designated game day.

A Villa Walsh Academy student is expected to be full uniform at all times, keeping in mind that it is to be worn appropriately and neatly.
